HEAD BOILERPERSON

The Head Boilerperson is Responsible for:

- Operation and maintenance of boilers, air conditioning, refrigeration equipment, pumps, condensers, and compressors, along with the operation of our Andover system building automation system, and maintain swimming pool to IDPH standards, performing preventative maintenance to keep readings at desired levels and extend life of equipment.
- Start up, regulate, repair, and shut down equipment. Ensuring equipment operates safely, economically, and within established guidelines and regulations.
- Testing pool water, boiler water, cooling tower water, condensate pan water, adjusting chemical treatment, and performing preventative maintenance to keep readings at desired levels and extend life of equipment.
- Installing, repairing, cleaning and performing preventative maintenance on all mechanical and HVAC equipment to maintain a comfortable quality of life for the school.
- Maintaining a preventative maintenance log on all equipment
- Reading blueprints and schematics, trace electrical control systems, and adjust valves.
- Supervision of the Assistant Boiler person.
- Must be available for emergency callbacks during holidays, weekends, and/or beyond the traditional work day.
- Must be physically able to perform the duties outlined above.
- Other duties as assigned.
