The Asst. HVAC Technician is responsible for:

- Operation and maintenance of boilers, air conditioning, refrigerant equipment, generators, pumps, condensers, along with the operation of our Andover /Siemens BAS, and maintain swimming pool to IDPH standards, performing preventative maintenance to keep readings to desired levels and extend life of equipment.
- Start up, regulate, repair and shut down equipment. Ensuring equipment operates safely, economically, and within established guidelines and regulations.
- Testing pool chemistry, boilers, cooling tower, condensate pan water, adjusting chemical treatment, performing preventative maintenance to keep levels within desired levels
- Reading blueprints and schematics, trace electrical controls systems and adjust valves.
- Installing, repairing, and performing preventative maintenance on all H.V.A.C.R. equipment.
- Must be available for emergency call backs during holidays, weekends, and /or beyond the traditional work day.
