



Taxpayers to Pay \$44 Million Less than Originally Projected

District 207 plans to take advantage of current low interest rates when it sells voter-approved bonds that will be used for school repairs and enhancements. It is projected these lower than anticipated rates will reduce the taxpayer burden by approximately \$44.2 million.

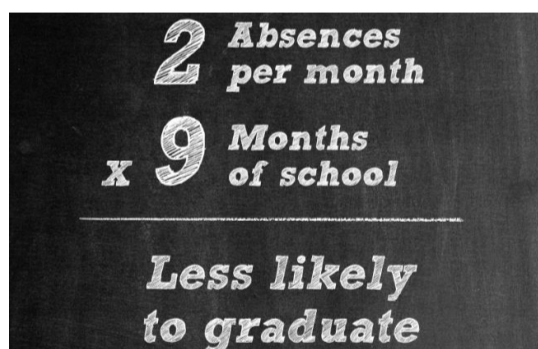
