# Virtual Graduation Information

Maine East, Maine South and Maine West high schools will hold virtual graduation ceremonies on Sunday, May 17. The virtual graduations will be released on each school's YouTube page at the following times:

> Maine East - 1 p.m. on May 17 - <u>Maine East YouTube Channel</u> Maine South - 3 p.m. on May 17 - <u>Maine South YouTube Channel</u> Maine West - 1 p.m. on May 17 - <u>Maine West YouTube Channel</u>

The graduation videos will be released as premiere videos, meaning viewers will not be able to skip ahead in the ceremony (much like a live sporting event). After the entire graduation has concluded, the video will remain on the YouTube page.

In addition, several local government access channels will air the graduation ceremonies: Des Plaines TV Ch. 24 (Comcast, WOW and ATT U-verse Ch. 99) Niles-TV (Comcast Ch. 6, AT&T U-verse Ch. 99 and streaming at <u>www.vniles.com/NTV</u>) Park Ridge (WOW Ch. 6 and Comcast Ch. 17)

Each school also will hold a drive through graduation parade for students and families that want to participate. The Maine East parade will be at 3 p.m. (more details on the Maine East parade). The Maine South parade will be at 1 p.m. (details on the Maine South parade will be shared by the school later this week). The Maine West parade will be at 3:30 p.m. (more details on the Maine West parade will be at 3:30 p.m. (more details on the Maine West parade).
