

Advertisement for Bids

The Board of Education of Maine Township High School District 207 ("Board"), will receive sealed bids for asbestos abatement work for the 2021 Renovation projects. The following three Bid Packages are being solicited:

- **Bid Package 1, Maine East High School Asbestos Abatement**
- **Bid Package 2, Maine South High School Asbestos Abatement**
- **Bid Package 3, Maine West High School Asbestos Abatement**

Bids shall be submitted in a sealed opaque envelope no later than the following dates:

Bid Package 1, Maine East High School, October 14, 2020 at 2:00 pm.

Bid Package 2, Maine South High School, October 15, 2020 at 2:00 pm.

Bid Package 3, Maine West High School, October 16, 2020 at 2:00 pm.

Bids for all three Bid Packages shall be delivered prior to the above dates and times to Maine Township High School District 207 Administrative Center located at 1177 South Dee Road, Park Ridge, Illinois 60068. Facsimile and electronic bids will not be accepted. Bidders are responsible for ensuring timely delivery of their bids; no late bids will be accepted. Bids will be opened and read aloud at the Maine Township High School District 207 Administrative Center located at 1177 South Dee Road, Park Ridge, Illinois 60068 at the Bid Due date, and time.

A MANDATORY pre-bid meeting and walk-through will be held on October 7, 2020 starting at 10:00am. The meeting will start at the Main Entrance of Maine South High School located at 1111 South Dee Road, Park Ridge, Illinois 60068. All three schools will be visited during the pre-bid meeting. All contractors submitting bids for these projects SHALL attend the pre-bid meetings at each school. The pre-bid meeting will also be attended by a representative of Maine Township High School District 207.

Bid security in the form of a bid bond, certified check, or cash in an amount equal to 5 percent of the base bid amount shall be submitted with the bid. The successful Contractor shall provide Labor and Material Bonds, and Performance Bonds for the work.

In accordance with the Prevailing Wage Act, all bidders shall guarantee that not less than the prevailing wage will be paid to laborers, workers and mechanics performing work under the contract.

The Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or any part thereof, and to waive any irregularities or technicalities in the bids.
