Input from the survey will be shared with the

50-member strategic planning team that includes students, community members, teachers, staff, Board of Education members, administrators and community leaders. The planning team will use the survey results, and additional information, to create a draft of the strategic plan. The draft plan will be shared with the

community to give an opportunity to provide feedback. A survey link for that feedback will be provided on the district website and through social media in January. Following that process, a strategic plan will be presented to the Board of Education for approval in the spring of 2026.

The Foundation has Provided more than \$400,000 to the Schools and District

Established in 1993, the Maine Township High School District Foundation (MTHS Foundation) is a non-profit organization whose mission is to provide resources to support student well-being and promote innovative learning opportunities for the students and staff in District 207.


To achieve these goals, the MTHS Foundation provides grants for creative and challenging enrichment activities, staff development of innovative instructional practices, student well-being initiatives and cooperative ventures among learning communities. These grants are available for District 207 staff to apply for throughout the year.

Amazing Support

Over the past 32 years, the MTHS Foundation has provided approximately 400 grants totalling more than \$400,000 to students and staff members. Grants for curriculum development and other innovative learning experiences support a variety of areas including fine and performing arts, civic education, writing and communication, technology in the curriculum, Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math (STEM and STEAM) experiences, school culture and student services.

The MTHS Foundation also supports district-wide programs benefiting all District 207 students including the School-Based Health Center (SBHC), peer tutoring programs, the KIND207 Fund and other support programs. The KIND207 Fund provides resources that allows the schools to identify and provide students in need with assistance who are facing dire family circumstances. The foundation recently donated \$50,000 to the SBHC allowing it to open a second clinic at Maine West. Additionally, the MTHS Foundation has donated to programs such as the COVID emergency fund in 2020 and scholarships.

"We are honored to work closely with District 207 school leaders to provide students with learning opportunities and resources beyond what is covered in regular budgets," shares MTHS Foundation Board of Trustees Chair David Hiller. "Through healthcare, career opportunities, field




next level when it hosted its first annual benefit. Held almost every year since, the benefit fundraises for various grants and programs.

In 2025, the MTHS Foundation's annual benefit focused on District 207's career pathways initiatives, which provides opportunities for students to experience and learn about potential careers and prepare for college or other post-high school opportunities. Support of the district's career pathways initiatives include helping students pay for AP exams and dual enrollment at local colleges, internships, apprenticeships and career certifications. The cost of some of these learning opportunities is beyond what some families can afford and the MTHS Foundation is helping ensure that all students have the chance to pursue their dreams.

"The foundation continues to be a powerful force for good in our schools," says District 207 Superintendent Dr. Tatiana Bonuma. "Its impact is visible in every inspired classroom, every student success story and every community initiative it helps bring to life."
