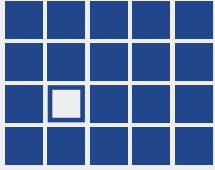

TWO WAYS TO REPORT AN ABSENCE — ON THE DAY IT HAPPENS

Online

Log in to Campus Parent, open Absence Requests, select your student, and choose an absence type.

By phone

Call your school's attendance office, 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Give the student's name and ID number, the reason, the date, and your name.

SOCIAL PRIVILEGE ELIGIBILITY

90% + On Time Starts day 1 of each semester

Social privilege eligibility is impacted when a student falls below 90% present and on-time and has outstanding detentions to serve. The 90% is calculated on a rolling basis each semester and includes unexcused absences (AU), vacation days (VAC), tardies (T), excessive tardies (TX), and other parent-approved unauthorized absences (PAU) that are not considered excused by the state.

Needed for Homecoming, Prom, Football Games, Senior Events and other privileges.



AUTOMATED DETENTIONS

Every 5th Starts September 8th

Assigned automatically at every fifth unexcused absence and/or excessive tardy of 10 minutes or more.

An email goes to the student and parent each time one is assigned.



SENIOR OFF-CAMPUS LUNCH

95% + No F's

UPDATED

Seniors earn the privilege by maintaining 95% attendance and no failing grades. The building exit scanner checks eligibility in real time, so improved grades or attendance restore eligibility the same day.



WEEKLY ATTENDANCE LETTER

Fridays Starts August 21st

Sent to students and families every Friday. It shows overall attendance percentage, social privilege percentage, grades, and absence and tardy counts by class.

No surprises. You will see both numbers every week.



PRACTICE, PERFORM, COMPETE

Same Day Attendance

A student who is absent (excused or unexcused) and/or excessively tardy (10 minutes or more) for more than two scheduled blocks may not actively participate in their extracurricular activity that day.

Applies to all athletics, fine arts, music ensembles, clubs and academic teams.

TARDY DETENTIONS

Every 5th Starts September 8th

Every fifth unexcused tardy to 1st or 2nd period now results in an automated detention. This year the system covers morning arrival only.

There are no tardies given if a bus is late; late passes are given upon entry.



MAKE-UP WORK

Upon Return

UPDATED

Students should communicate with their teacher and expect to complete missed assessments and submit missed work upon return to class. Work assigned on the day of the absence will have at least one class meeting extension, but will not be accepted after the unit summative.



ATTENDANCE SUPPORT PLANS

For students with inconsistent attendance, staff work with the student and family to identify what is getting in the way and build a plan to address it.

ABSENCE REPORTING

Same Day

Parents/guardians are required to report an absence on the day it occurs, before the end of the school day. Unreported absences are recorded as unexcused.

Reminders are sent at 10:15 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. if your child's absence has not been reported.
